VOLUNTEER POSITION	POSITION DESCRIPTION
412 Food Distribution	Meet the 412 food driver one day a week. Separate food evenly between the four houses. Deliver food to each house & place in refrigerator.
Events Fundraising	Help brainstorm, plan, and set up events and fundraising opportunities with Resurrection Power staff.
Gardening	Work to pull weeds, plant flowers, etc. This is a seasonal position.
Handi-Work	Has knowledge and expertise to help with minor and everyday issues around the houses. Utilize skills such as HVAC, plumbing, painting, construction, electrical, etc.
Mentoring	If a resident would like a mentor, then this volunteer would be available to support and guide the resident as needed. Examples: share a meal, shop, teach a skill or lend an ear. On an as-needed basis. (Gender specific)
Office	This depends on the needs of the Operations Director. Examples: scanning, filing, entering data, picking up mail & stamps, etc.
Provide Transportation	Many of our residents do not have vehicles. This volunteer would be willing (as needed) to take a resident to the store, doctor's appointments, work, Christian recovery bible study. (Gender specific)
Spirituality Leader	This volunteer would meet the residents at their house and lead them once a week in learning about spiritual matters. (Gender specific)
Supplies	Once every two weeks, this volunteer will shop for house supply needs at Sams/Walmart and deliver what is needed to each of the four houses.
Volunteer Coordinator	Central point of contact for volunteers. This volunteer would participate in outreach, collect questionnaires, collect background checks and spiritual gifts inventory.
